B Student B has got information about Lake Synevyr. Use the prompts to ask him/ her questions, and complete the fact file.





Lake Synevyr

Lake Synevyr is the biggest mountain lake in all of Ukraine. It's very high, almost 1,000 metres above the sea. The lake is not too big, just 7 hectares and its deepest point is 24 metres deep. A big earthquake formed the lake about 10,000 years ago.

Now, Synevyr is a national park. It's very beautiful with mountains all around. More than 43 animal species live within or around the lake. Visitors can enjoy a variety of activities such as hiking, bird watching, and boating, making it a perfect destination for nature enthusiasts and tourists. There's a tiny island in the middle of the lake called the 'Sea Eye', which is only a few meters long!
